PERMISSION TO PRACTICE BEFORE THE PUEBLO OF ACOMA TRIBAL COURT (PROFESSIONAL ATTORNEY)

In accordance with the Pueblo of Acoma Law and Order Code (effective 12/13/2003) Professional attorneys may practice before the Courts of the Pueblo of Acoma provided that any such attorney is properly admitted to practice, before the courts. In order to grant permission to practice the following admission criteria must be adhered to:

Any attorney who is a member of the New Mexico State Bar, or any attorney certified and eligible to practice before the Courts of any other state in the United States is eligible to be admitted to practice before the Courts of the Pueblo of Acoma. To practice before the Courts, any attorney must certify or show:

- 1. The he/she is a member of the New Mexico State Bar or any other State of the United States.
- 2. That he/she must provide an original Certificate of Good Standing for their respective State.
- 3. That he/she will abide by the Rule of the Acoma Courts and any orders issued by the Courts.
- 4. That he/she is knowledgeable and is generally informed about the people and their traditions and their traditions and customs.
- 5. Payment fee of \$100.00 per annum is required.
- 6. Submit to a sworn oath of office.

Professional attorneys must be approved, and fees paid before an Entry of Appearance is filed with the Acoma Tribal Courts. Approved professional attorneys may appear in civil and criminal matters.
